2017 Rosé Of Pinot Gris

Territorial Wines was founded in 2001 by Jeff & Victoria Wilson-Charles and Alan & April Mitchell. Wines are made by Ray Walsh and grown by Alan Mitchell on estate owned and estate-managed vineyards in Lane County. Annual production is around 5,000 cases.

The winery is located in downtown Eugene's funky Whiteaker neighborhood in the old Boyds Coffee Warehouse.

WILLIAM FEVRE WINERY
(SAN LUIS DE PIRQUE, CHILE)

2015 La Mision Reserva Especial

Maipo Valley Carmenère

If there is one name in the Burgundy region synonymous with superlative, long-lasting Chablis then it is undoubtedly William Fevre. So how did he get to San Luis de Pirque? Fevre was hunting for terroir to produce Chardonnay outside of France. When he arrived in South America, he thought it odd the Chilean wine producers grew fruit down on the flat lands and he sought a parcel up higher in the mountains. He partnered with Victor Pino Torche, who owned vineyards on the banks of the Maipo River, and began crafting wines in a Burgundian style, slowly, on a smaller scale, barrel by barrel.

We do not measure our success by how many bins of grapes leave the vineyard on harvest day, but rather by what shows up in the bottle. As owners of our own estate vineyard and an urban winery, we are unfettered by vineyard economics and free to concentrate on quality alone.

This Vin Gris style rosé drinks like a classic Mediterranean rosé. A pretty copper color in the glass resulting from a two day cold soak on the blue and gun-metal gray skins of the Pinot Gris grape. Floral ripe green pear notes and green apple avors and aromas. A grown-up palate, yet vibrant and lively in the mouth. Finishing with a frisson of citric architecture.

Fifteen years later, William Fevre has produced the top 2 Carmeneres for the price in all of Chile.

Carmenere with a splash of Cabernet Franc, La Mision's dark, rich fruit is complemented by eight months in French oak. Red-violet in color, brilliant and vivid, this Reserve Especial shows ripe blackberries, tobacco, and spices. Juicy, full-bodied, and concentrated with plush tannins and a long, lingering finish.

"Pretty aromatics with herbal and garrigue scents. Very Carmenere on the palate, with supple tannins engraved by an exquisite floral character and enlivened by bright and finely poised acidity. Graceful black fruit aromas lead to a juicy, rounded and succulent palate with abundant length and elegance - beautiful stuff."
