Winespeak 101

This week's question: What's an "AVA"?

You may have noticed this three-letter acronym adorn many a fine bottle of wine, typically preceded by a location that includes a geographical feature (e.g., 'valley', 'mountains', 'ridge', etc). What you are seeing is an *American Viticultural Area*, or a region of wine grape-growing in the United States that is distinguishable by geographic features, with boundaries defined by the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB) of the US Department of the Treasury. AVAs range in size from the Upper Mississippi River Valley AVA at 29,900 square miles across four states to the Cole Ranch AVA in Mendocino County, California, at only 60 acres. The TTB defines AVAs at the request of wineries and other petitioners. Once an AVA is established, at least 85% of the grapes used to make a wine must be grown in the specified area if an AVA is referenced on its label. This serves to give consumers confidence that a bottle possessing a particular AVA contains a wine that is truly representative of that region. Currently, Oregon is home to 18 AVAs throughout the state.
