New Beer



MODERN TIMES
(SAN DIEGO, CA)

City Of The Sun

IPA loaded with sticky, fruity new wave hops redolent of melon, lime, and citrus notes. The flavor is as complex as it is aggressive, featuring a stiff bitterness and a powerfully tropical hop character, backed by a dry, barely-there malt backbone.

LOMPOC
(PORTLAND, OR)

Lomporter

A premium porter that offers a creamy taste of dark chocolate complemented by dark cherry and hints of coffee. Brewed with dark wheat, rausch, and chocolate malts, this beer strikes a fine balance between heavy and light.

MATCHLESS
(TUMWATER, WA)

Brunch MOB

Dubbed a 'Beermosa-style ale', this is an ultra light lager with a giant dry hopping of Topaz, Galaxy and H. Blanc. Almost an IPA in character, but super low in bitterness and with almost no malt to get in the way of the intense citrus, tropical fruit and sparkling wine delightfulness.

MATCHLESS
(TUMWATER, WA)

Dallah

This big-bodied milk stout was inspired by the coffee of the Arabian Gulf region. Spiced with cardamom for a touch of warmth for the cold months ahead--just as traditionally done with Arabic coffee. As rich in flavor as the ornate coffee pot this beer owes it name to, this beer is perfect to sip on a brisk winter day!

DOGFISH HEAD
(MILTON, DE)

120 Minute IPA

The One and Only! Continuously hopped with a copious amount of high-alpha American hops throughout the boil and whirlpool, and then dry-hopped with another pallet of hops. Unfiltered and abundantly hoppy, it's the Holy Grail for hopheads!

ST BERNARDUS
(BELGIUM)

Christmas Ale

This specialty beer is characterized by its deep dark color, with a creamy, thick head and a full, almost velvety taste with a fruity nose. Brewed annually for the holiday season, the long winter nights are perfect moments to savor this ale and to enjoy its unique and complex taste.

FONTANAFREDDA
(ITALY)

Già Langhe Rosso 2013 Red Blend

The winemaking history of Fontanafredda was established in 1878 by Emanuele Guerrieri, Count of Mirafiore, son of King Vittorio Emanuele II of Sardinia and Rosa Vercellana [or La Bela Rusin], a "commoner" that the king had fallen in love with. The 54 hectare estate was given to Rosa Vercellana by the king in 1858. Emanuele Guerrieri devoted his life to crafting wine. Located in the heart of the Langhe, today the estate is renowned for its captivating Barolo and Barbaresco wines.

Crafted from a blend of the red grape varietals that define the Langhe region: Dolcetto, Nebbiolo and Barbera. Released young--only 3 months after harvesting--this wine captures the youth and vitality of the component varietals, yet displays rustic complexity and a balance that belies its absence of cellaring.

"Dark garnet in color with inviting aromas of cherry pie and soft baking spices. Simple and pleasant, with a shake of pepper over concentrated red and black cherry flavours and bright acidity. Tart fruit and bitter almond join smooth tannins on the dry finish. A fantastic value and versatile companion at the table."

PANTHER CREEK
(DUNDEE, OR)

Winemaker's Cuvée 2017 Willamette Valley Pinot Noir

One of the oldest wineries in the Willamette Valley, Panther Creek was founded in 1986 by Ken Wright. The winery focuses on signature blends as well as single vineyard designate wines. Panther Creek utilizes the talents of superstar winemaker Tony Rynders, who has worked over 20 harvests spanning the globe, from France to Australia.

Panther Creek's flagship offering is a blend of Pinot Noir from vineyards in the Willamette Valley which were selected for their richness, complexity and structure.

"The nose of this refined Pinot Noir features strawberries, black cherry and chocolate, with a hint of raspberry. The palate has notes of black currant, coffee, and a hint of tobacco that's rounded out by soft tannins and a balanced finish."
