Momentary Lapse of Reason

New England Style DIPA brewed & dry hopped w/ Citra & El Dorado hops. Juicy & easy drinking, this beer carries notes of orange, citrus, & dankness.

Juicy Bits

This chestnut-colored top-fermenting beer w/ secondary fermentation in the bottle has a promising fragrance with a hint of herbs and spices. Begins floral & slightly sweet, evolves from light caramel to a nice & dry hop bitterness. In the long aftertaste the bitters flow together w/ a pleasant spiciness in the background.



"This organic grape Chardonnay wine was picked in Feb 2013 and impresses for the price. The wine has aromas of poached pear, mushroom, cashew and red delicious apple. This leads to flavors of starfruit, Bartlett pear, red delicious apple, vanilla cream and brioche. Lovely texture and mousse that represents a wonderful value in sparkling wine."

LA FIERA (ITALY)

Since 1928, the Botter family has been producing wines under environmentally friendly policies and with innovative production techniques and technologies. Today, the company is managed by the family's third generation and specializes in wines of the region local to Veneto, Italy.

The brand's carousel theme comes from medieval riding fairs in the north of Italy. These elaborate "equestrian ballets" took place in royal courts and featured lavishly decorated horses and highly skilled riders performing synchronized formations. Popularity lead builders to replicate them by designing rotating platforms with mounted wooden horses for children to ride. The carousel has been the centerpiece of La Fiera, "The Fair", for centuries.

2017 Primitivo Salento

A dark, ruby-red color with violet highlights. Intense and fragrant bouquet with a rich jammy dark fruits and soft tannins.

"Jammy red berry aromas and flavors mix with grilled herbs and are grounded by a sanguine vein. Medium in weight and structure, the acidity starts off soft but builds on the mid palate, offering a bit of levity on the finish."
