## Wine

This week features new additions to our fantastic import wine selection.

### New Wine



#### VILLA POZZI (SICILY)

The Pozzi's are a fifth generation winemaking family, originally from Cremona, in Northern Italy. The family's great grandfather became well known throughout the province for his wine business. His horse-drawn wagons traveled over undeveloped country roads carrying barrels of the best wines from different regions of Italy. Grandfather Pozzi did well – especially with the wines he found in Sicily. In 2006 the family realized a generation-old dream to make their own Sicilian wines, and Villa Pozzi was born. Using only superior quality grapes and controlled production, the wines follow the family motto of 'Res non Verba' – Deeds, Not Words.

### 2017 Pinot Grigio Sicily

Fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks to ensure a fresh, fruity, and crisp wine. It showcases aromas of lemon, white peach, and pear. It's clean and well balanced with bright acidity, and the finish lingers with notes of stone fruit and flowers. This wine is perfect for sipping on its own or for enjoying with any kind of seafood or vegetable dish.



#### SAGER & MASTER (FRANCE)

Exem Bordeaux is 100% estate produced in Lestiac-sur-Garonne, a little village 15km southeast of Bordeaux along the right bank of the Garonne river. Eric Gonfrier and his brother Philippe run this 400 hectare private estate, and have contracts with other growers to complete the range. Philippe is in charge of the viticulture, and Eric is the winemaker and the salesman. Their vineyards are located along the Southeastern edge of the "Entre-Deux-Mers" region, but contained within in the Premières Cotes de Bordeaux appellation. The vineyard management is sustainable.

### 2016 Bordeaux Rouge Merlot / Cabernet Sauvignon

Aromas of ripe red and black fruits. The palate is rich and harmonious with soft and elegant tannins, profiling perfectly ripe fruit (a rarity in Bordeaux).

"Soft and fruity, this lightly structured wine is rich and dense. Its blackberry fruit is supported by balanced tannins and acidity. Made to be enjoyed young, so drink up."
